Thriving Neighborhoods

Funds will be used to improve the vitality of neighborhoods in the City and County of Schenectady. Funds may be granted for the purposes of beautification, public safety, housing, environmental improvement, resident engagement, resident health and well-being, non-profit building and facility improvements, and other projects promoting revitalization.

Opportunity Youth

Funds are devoted to improving the educational, vocational and social outcomes for young people in the City and County of Schenectady – particularly those youth who are disengaged or at risk of being disconnected from school or job opportunities.

Community Health & Well-being

Funds will improve the health and well-being of community members, supporting health providers and stakeholders to address health disparities, reduce negative health indicators, to develop effective outreach and prevention programs, and to improve the capacity of the health system to be responsive to community need.

Ready to Learn

Distributions shall promote the health and development of pre-school aged children in the City and County of Schenectady, enabling them to enter school ready to learn and to succeed. Grants may address maternal and infant health, quality child care and pre-school opportunities, social-emotional health and development, child mental health, literacy and nutrition, among other issues.
