



Tribute Park SCHENECTADY LAND BANK EASTERN AVENUE NEIGHBORHOOD

As part of the revitalization of the Eastern Avenue neighborhood, derelict buildings at the project site were demolished, and an urban pocket park was established. Nearly 1/2 an acre, the park was designed with neighborhood residents' input and ideas related to how they would utilize the green space. The project included the installation of a splash pad, benches and tables, and plenty of green space for the enjoyment of

neighbors and other City residents.

Since the park's opening, the space has been well-utilized by neighborhood kids (and adults!) cooling off on the splash pad, playing games of kickball in the central green space, and gathering for small parties and celebrations in the sitting area. Tribute Park has proven to be a welcome and beneficial asset to the Eastern Avenue neighborhood.
